

Pool Renovations

- 6. And finally – Ask for references and call or visit pool owners that have had work done by the contractor.**

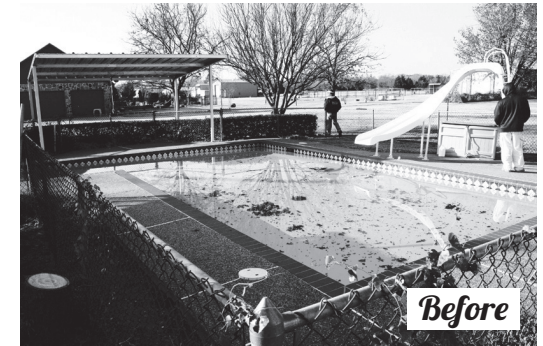
By selecting the right contractor, you will be ready to start the swim season next spring with a “new” pool that should provide many more years of enjoyment.
